PUNCTUALITY

- ***** Wearing ID cards daily is mandatory for all students.

COMMUNICATION

- Check and sign your child's Parent-Teacher Link book daily for updates and important information.
- ***** Read the link-book thoroughly especially page no. 6 to 12.
- ✤ Address all communication to the Principal through the class teacher for efficient coordination.
- ✤ Notify the school promptly regarding any changes in contact details to ensure effective communication.
- Stay updated about school activities and information to remain involved in your child's education.
- ***** Report any medical issues to the school counsellor and class teacher for appropriate support and assistance.
- ✤ Inform the school about leave using the prescribed leave format to facilitate smooth administration.
- Syllabus sheet will be provided, which will contain all the outline of the topics, assignments, and expectations.

<u>UNIFORM</u>

- Ensure your child wears the prescribed neat and clean uniform daily.(Refer to page no. 8 and 9 of the Link- Book)
- Uniforms should be properly ironed to maintain a tidy appearance.
- ✤ Make sure your child comes to school in complete school uniform, including all required elements.
- Boys should have a proper haircut, while girls should come with their hair styled in two plaits for a neat and tidy appearance.
- School uniform of girls got modified from suits to trousers

RESPONSIBILITY

- ◆ Label all belongings with the child's name, admission number, and class to prevent loss or mix-ups.
- Ensure books are covered and maintained properly to prolong their lifespan and keep them in good condition.
- Submit required documents within the first week of joining to complete administrative formalities efficiently.
- ◆ Facilitate homework but avoid doing it yourself to encourage independent learning and responsibility.
- Adhere to pick-up and drop-off timings to ensure smooth operations and safety of all students.
- Pack school bags carefully as no items will be allowed to be delivered to school after it starts, promoting responsibility and preparedness.
- Expensive items are not allowed on school premises to prevent loss or theft and maintain a focus on learning.

SAFETY & SECURITY

- Ensure students use licensed transport services for their safety and security during commute.
- Parents should refrain from visiting during school hours without a prior appointment to minimize disruptions to the learning environment.
